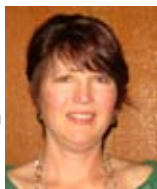

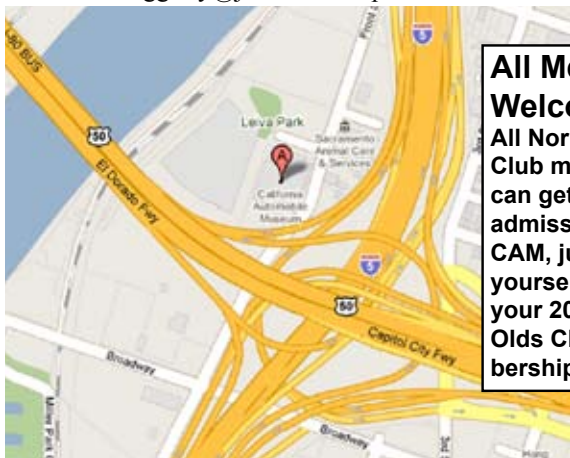

After cars were parked and banners hung, Car Show Chair Jon Manji held a very informative judging seminar. At noon we had a very delicious lunch prepared by Tony and Denise LaCentra. They prepared tri-tip steak with grilled onions, french bread, beans the works. This coupled with the potluck side dishes, it was delicious with all praises and no complaints. Thanks to all volunteer members that stepped up with their help, Karen Nicosia at registration, Jerry North and others at parking, Jeff Peck, banners, Denise La Centra table prep, and many others. 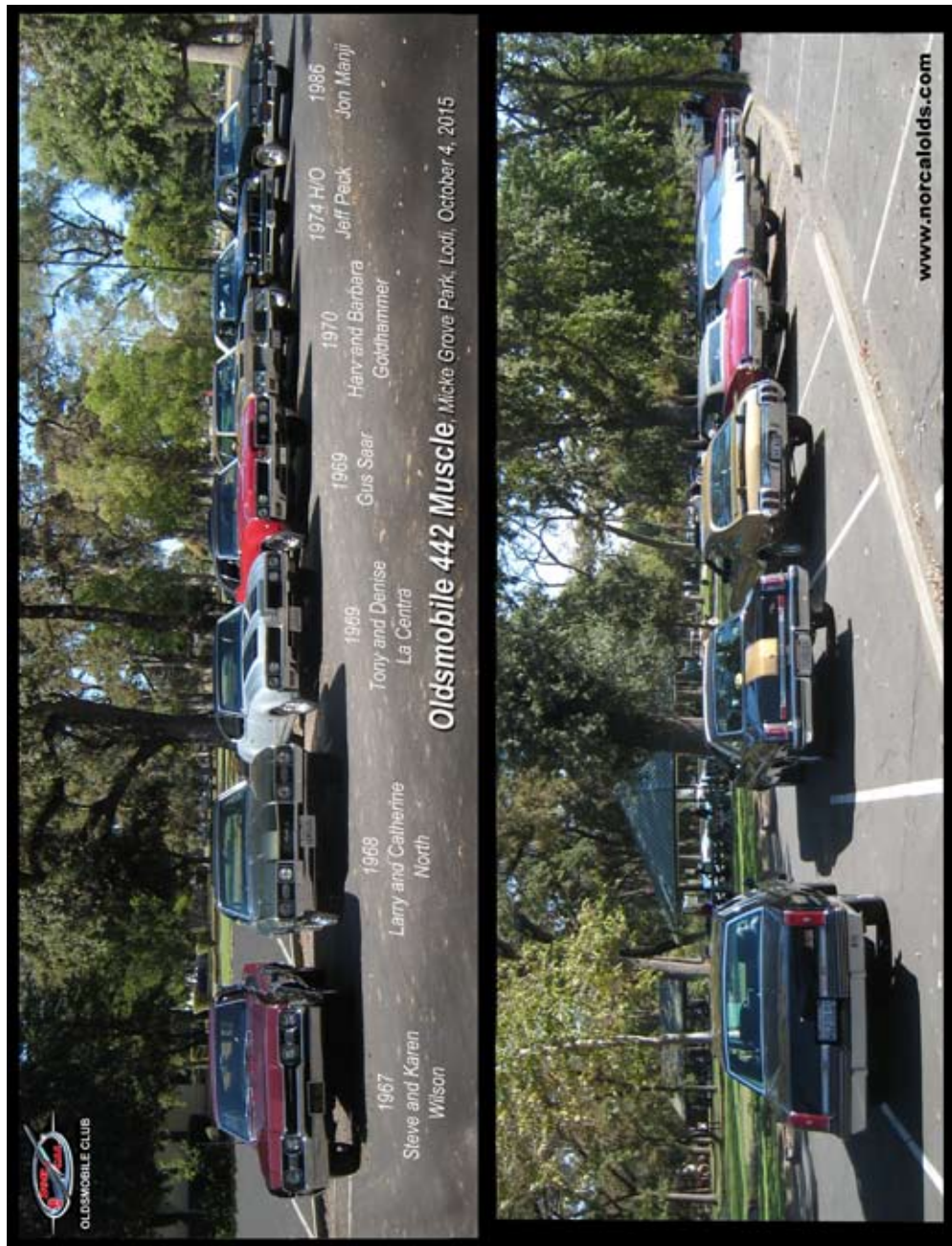

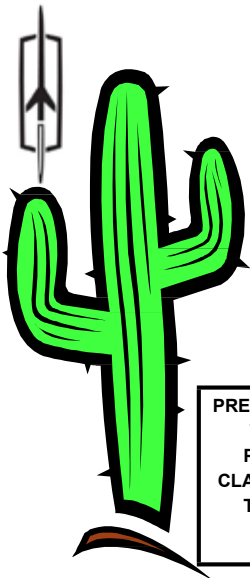
